NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

The City Council for the City of Horace, North Dakota, will receive sealed bids until 10:30 a.m. on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2010, at the office of Houston Engineering, Inc., 1401 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue North, Fargo, ND 58102, and they will be publicly opened and read at 10:30 a.m. on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2010, for the supplying of all labor and materials necessary for the construction of Drainage Improvement District No. 10-1.

The scope of work consists of furnishing and installing the following approximate quantities:

Work shall be done according to the plans and specifications which are on file and may be seen at the office of the City Auditor at Horace, North Dakota, and at the office of the Engineer.

Paper copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained from the office of Houston Engineering, Inc., 1401 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue North, Fargo, ND 58102, upon payment of \$50.00, nonrefundable.

Each bid must be accompanied by a separate envelope containing a Bidder's Bond in a sum equal to five percent (5%) of the full amount of the bid, executed by the bidder as principal, and by surety, conditioned that if the principal's bid is accepted and the contract awarded to the principal, the principal within ten (10) days after notice of the award shall execute a contract in

accordance with the terms of the bid, and a contractor's bond is required by law and the regulations and determinations of the governing body.

A bidder must be licensed for the full amount of the bid as required by Section 43-07-05 of the North Dakota Century Code. **THE REQUIRED BID BOND ENVELOPE SHALL ALSO CONTAIN A COPY OF THE CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE OF RENEWAL THEREOF, ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE AS REQUIRED BY LAW.**

No bid may be read or considered if it does not fully comply with the requirements of this section, and any deficient bid submitted must be resealed and returned to the bidder immediately. As soon as the bid prices have been compared, the owner will return the bonds to all except the three lowest responsible bidders.

When the Contract is awarded, the bonds of the remaining unsuccessful bidders will be returned. The bond of the successful bidder will be retained until the Agreement and Surety Bond have been executed and approved, after which it will be returned. The project shall be completed by October 22, 2010 based on an award date of August 9, 2010.

The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to waive any informalities therein.
